- All competition items must be submitted to the Fiber Loft by 5:00 pm on either Wednesday Aug. 21, 10am-5pm or Thursday, Aug. 22, 10am-3pm
- An attendant will assign you a number and give you tags to be placed on your articles.
- Classes will be divided by age of competitor.
- 21 years and younger will be considered Youth, 22 years and older will be considered Adult.
- All competition items must be created using yarn of at least 50% natural animal fibers.
- All competition judging will be done on Friday prior to the Fair opening.

## Handspun Skein

- Plied yarn demonstrating even twist and good handle.
- Novelty yarn spun using such techniques as tufted, boucle, core spun and so forth.
- Most colorful judged on variety of color and aesthetics.

## Wearables

### 1. Sweaters, vests, shawls, ponchos:

Must be created using yarn of at least 50% natural animal fiber.

Shirt, dress, slacks, etc. Must be created using material of at least 50% natural animal fiber.
