4. All entries must conform to the standards of the department. No prize will be awarded to entries judged unworthy.
5. All entries entered will be grouped and classified.
6. Only one entry per category.
7. Please pick up prize ribbons and vouchers no later than 5:00 pm.
8. All plates, dishes, etc. not picked up will become the property of the Champlain Valley Fair after Sunday, September, 5.
9. No prizes will be mailed.

NEW THIS YEAR!

There will be a cumulative award for the entire week of the fair! Each entry you submit you will be awarded 1 point. You will then be able to further accumulate points by winning competitions.

Baking competitions (1st & 2nd Saturday Show):
1st: 3 pts; 2nd: 2 pts; 3rd: 1 pt.

All other competitions:
1st: 5 pts; 2nd: 3 pts; 3rd: 2 pts.
