To enter your items in this year's fair, please email Jody with your name, address, phone number and number of tags you will need prior to August 1st. For new exhibitors, you will receive your exhibitor number with your tags.

Home Crafts will be open daily 10am – 10pm for viewing and purchases.

Rules

1. Article drop off times are Saturday, August 17 from 12-7pm and Sunday, August 18 from 10am-5pm at the Blue Ribbon Pavilion. No entries will be accepted after these dates.
2. All articles submitted must be hand made by the exhibitor.
3. Soiled, broken, or unpleasant smelling articles will be removed from selling floor. Superintendent reserves the right to reject any entry determined unworthy.
4. Exhibitors must tag all articles with a CV Expo tag prior to drop off. Each tag shall be attached to the article by safety pin or string. Tags must be typed or written legibly and filled out completely. The tag shall contain the Exhibitor's number and an individualized article number. Numbering of individualized articles shall begin with "1" and continue in sequence until all articles are numbered. The information on the tag shall correspond with the information provided by Exhibitor on the CV Expo Home Crafts Entry Order Form. Articles must be priced in increments of \$.50 only. Superintendent reserves the right to reject articles improperly tagged
5. Each exhibitor may enter only one article per class for judging. Articles will be judged by the category they are entered into.
6. Items brought in for judging must not have been previously judged at this fair. Judges have discretion to move or remove items. Judge's decision is final.
7. On items to be judged: Remove or cover up name, youth crafters list age on tag, division and class for article judged must be located on tag.
8. CV Fair retains 22% of selling price as commission for each and all items sold.
9. CV Fair is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen articles. We make every reasonable effort to provide security and control.
10. Prize vouchers may be collected starting August 27th.
11. All quilts must have dimensions listed on tag.
12. Wearables must have sizing and washing instructions on tag.

13. 500-piece limit per exhibitor.
14. Youth Crafters: Persons 16 years of age and younger will be given special consideration.
15. Youth Best of Show: Judge will select one article from youth classes as Youth Best of Show. A \$10 prize and special ribbon will be awarded.
16. Best of Division: Judge will select one article from each class as the Best of Division. A \$5 prize and special ribbon will be awarded.
17. Adult Best of Show: Judge will select one article as Best of Show from all articles entered. A \$25 prize and special ribbon will be awarded.
18. Pickup of unsold articles and payment for sold articles is Thursday, September 5 from 10am -5pm. No articles may be picked up before this date. Articles not picked up on September 5 will be held by the Superintendent until October 1st after which they become property of the Champlain Valley Expo.
