To enter your items in this year's fair, please email Jody with your name, address, phone number, and number of tags you will need **prior to July 31st**. For new exhibitors, you will receive your exhibitor number with your tags. Home Crafts will be open daily during hours set by fair administration for viewing and purchases.

## Rules

1. Article drop off times are Saturday, August 22 from 12-5pm and Sunday, August 23 from 10am-5pm at the Blue Ribbon Pavilion. No entries will be accepted after these dates.
2. All articles submitted must be handmade by the exhibitor.
3. Soiled, broken, or unpleasant smelling articles will be removed from selling floor. Superintendent reserves the right to reject any entry determined unworthy.
4. Exhibitors must tag all articles with a CV Expo tag prior to drop off. Each tag shall be attached to the article by safety pin or string. Tags must be typed or written legibly and filled out completely. The tag shall contain the Exhibitor's number and an individualized article number. Numbering of individualized articles shall begin with "1" and continue in sequence until all articles are numbered. The information on the tag shall correspond with the information provided by Exhibitor on the CV Expo Home Crafts Entry Order Form. Articles must be priced in increments of \$.50 only. Superintendent reserves the right to reject articles improperly tagged.
5. Superintendent has the sole discretion concerning the display of submitted articles. Exhibitors are encouraged to use self-provided display racks and panels that can be accommodated on a normal tabletop or in limited floor space. Any self-provided method of display must be approved by the Superintendent. All approved display racks and panels must be marked with Exhibitor's assigned number.
6. CV Fair retains 22% of selling price as commission for each and all items sold.
7. CV Fair is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen articles. Exhibitor assumes all risk related to damaged, lost, or stolen articles.
8. All quilts must have dimensions listed on tag.
9. Wearables must have sizing and washing instructions on tag.
10. There is a 500-piece limit per exhibitor.
11. Pickup of unsold articles and payment for sold articles is Thursday, September 10 from 10am -5pm. No articles

may be picked up before this date. Articles not picked up on September 10 will be held by the Superintendent until September 30th after which they become property of the Champlain Valley Expo.

12. Exhibitors wishing to submit articles for judging must use the judging forms provides in the Exhibitor Handbook. Each exhibitor may enter only one article per class for judging. Articles will be judged by the category they are entered into. Judging will be on Monday, August 24.
13. Items brought in for judging must not have been previously judged at this fair. Judges, in consultation with the Superintendent, have discretion to move or remove items.
14. Judge's decision is final.
15. All information identifying the exhibitor should be removed from item submitted for judging. Youth crafters must list their age on the tag for items to be judged. Division and class must be listed on the tag for each article to be judged.
16. Prize vouchers may be collected starting September 1st.
17. Youth Crafters: Persons 16 years of age and younger will be given special consideration in judging.
18. Youth Best of Show: Judge will select one article from youth classes as Youth Best of Show. A \$10 prize and special ribbon will be awarded.
19. Best of Division: Judge will select one article from each class as the Best of Division. A \$5 prize and special ribbon will be awarded.
20. Adult Best of Show: Judge will select one article as Best of Show from all articles entered. A \$25 prize and special ribbon will be awarded.
